Carmen Wiley, Ph.D., DABCC, FAACC joined Incyte Diagnostics in August. Dr. Wiley will serve as the CLIA Medical Director of Incyte's new clinical laboratory, as well as the clinical labs at Providence Sacred Heart Medical Center, Holy Family, Mt. Carmel, and St. Joseph's.



Dr. Wiley is a graduate of the University of Washington with a MS in Organic Chemistry and a PhD in Bioorganic Chemistry. She then completed a fellowship at the Mayo Clinic.

Dr. Wiley has been a resident of Spokane since April 2009 when she took on the role of Director of Chemistry, Immunology and Point of Care at the PHC hospital labs. She joined PAML in 2013 as the Scientific Director, where she was responsible for the medical and scientific oversight of all laboratory testing and the research and development program.

Additionally, Dr. Wiley held the very prestigious role of President of the American Association of Clinical Chemistry (AACC) in 2019 and is currently serving as Past President of this 50,000+ member professional society.



Tim Hawley, PMP, MLS (ASCP), has been selected as Laboratory Manager for Incyte Diagnostics' clinical laboratory. Tim will replace Pat Burke who is re-retiring in October after spending the past 18 months helping build the clinical laboratory from scratch to a state-of-the-art laboratory to serve the region.

Tim graduated from Eastern Washington University with a Bachelor of Science degree and completed his Medical Laboratory Scientist (MLS) internship at Providence Sacred Heart Medical Center School for Medical Technology. He worked in PAML's Science, Technology and Innovation Group where he supported developing new tests across a variety of departments.

In 2017, Tim accepted the Laboratory Manager position at Benewah Community Hospital where he managed the conversion from Meditech to Cerner's Electronic Health Records system, ensured compliance with CLIA regulations and developed new tests to increase clinician and patient satisfaction while reducing turn-around times. In July of 2019, Tim joined the Incyte clinical lab team as the Chemistry Supervisor. He helped in the design of the new laboratory, validated over 120 tests on the Roche Cobas Chemistry-Immunochemistry line, wrote all the SOPs for the new tests and supported the development of the Orchard Harvest Copia LIS.
